

I. Curriculum




Discussion:

Based on the response received from students it was found that 87 % of the students strongly agreed and 6% of students agreed and 7% of the students were neutral about the structure of the curriculum and its comprehensiveness, relevancy and proper arrangement. In the case of the effectiveness of the curriculum in enhancing skills to take up a career in business management, administration and entrepreneurship, 98% of students strongly agreed, 2% of Students agreed.. 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II. Teaching Learning and Proctorship




Discussion:



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IV. Infrastructure & Facilities:




Discussion:

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V. Academic Governance:




Discussion:

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VI. Activities and Events




Discussion:
