

**I. Curriculum**




**Discussion:**



## II. Teaching Learning and Proctorship




### Discussion:





#### IV. Infrastructure & Facilities:




#### Discussion:



## V. Academic Governance:




### Discussion:

## VI. Activities and Events




### Discussion:
