
ASTHA School of Management Analysis report on STUDENT FEEDBACK (2021-2022)

The institute draws feedback from students for continuous improvements in curriculum development and enrichment. For the session 2021-22, the analysis of student's feedback is presented as under:


I. Curriculum


II. Teaching Learning and Proctorship




IV. Infrastructure & Facilities:


V. Academic Governance:


VI. Activities and Events
