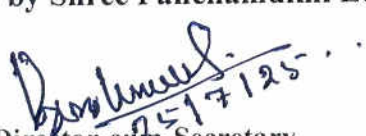

Item 1: Review of annual academic and administrative activities

Item 4: Preparation of annual quality assurance report


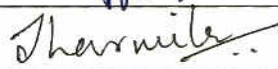
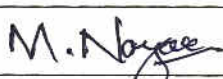

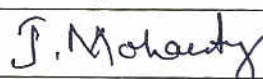

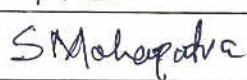


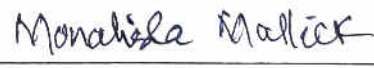
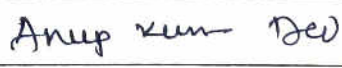
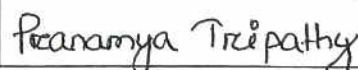

1: Discussion on academic planning for the session 2025-26

The IQAC Coordinator, Asst. Prof. Manoranjan Nayak, welcomed all the members and discussed the quality initiatives for the academic year 2025-26. 4: Planning for workshops, seminars and FDPs

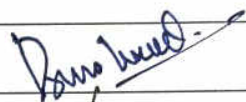
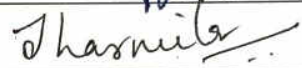
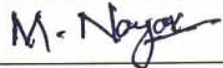


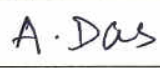




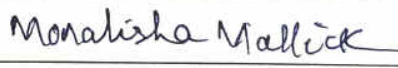

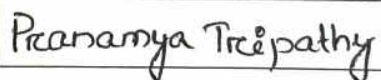
The committee decided to organize at least two workshops and one Faculty Development Programme (FDP) during the semester.

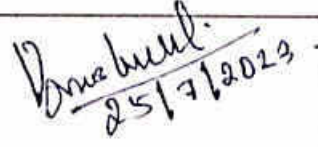

As per the requirements of the quorum, the meeting commenced only after the arrival of at least two-third of the members. After the welcome address by Asst. Prof. Manoranjan Nayak, the meeting started as per the agenda, presided by the Chairperson of IQAC Prof. (Dr.) Sharmila Subramanian.

Points of Discussion:

1. Prof. Dr. Sharmila Subramanian Welcomed all Members of IQAC.

2. The IQAC Coordinator presented the Plan of Action for the AY 2023-24 for feedback, suggestions and approval. The Annual Events' Calendar was also presented for approval. However, it was informed to the house that the BPUT Calendar was yet to be released and there could be minor modifications in the calendar for which prior approval of the IQAC quorum was needed.

3. All the members were in agreement of approving the calendar.

4. The key highlights of the AY 2023-24 plan were:

- a) Successful completion of NAAC accreditation process.
- b) Conducting ASTHA AVISHEK and the induction program effectively.
- c) Field visit to integrate modern management with IKS.
- d) Adding e-resources for improving teaching learning process.
- e) Conducting National Seminar, Prakarpa, Learning Vistas, Marketing Conclave, and Management Conclave
- f) Creating a closed venue to conduct Shuttle Smashers-2023
- g) Smooth conducting of examination and mapping CO-PO-PSO.
- h) Participating in BPUT Evaluation work as per the university notification
- i) Conducting community development programmes through SEA and FUN WITH PURPOSE
- j) Participating in outreach programmes
- k) Partnering Let's Shuttle with Sambad Group
- l) Conducting YUGMA by inviting the Hon'ble VC of BPUT & Hon'ble VC of Sambalpur University
- m) Conducting Annual FDP
- n) Conducting Research, Training & Consultancy for the Corporate

o) Collecting feedback and implementation of the recommendation.

3. Asst. Prof. Sthitipragyan Biswal narrated and emphasized on the importance of conducting AICTE sponsored Seminar, and FDP

4. Asst. Prof. Abhipsa Mishra stressed upon a paradigm shift from traditional teaching methodology to case based teaching for better quality teaching.

5. Asst. Prof. Dipan Kumar Jena stressed upon the need for educating students on the issues related to Anti Ragging. He also informed the house about the necessity to submit affidavit.

6. Mrs. Bishnupriya Biswal, trustee, suggested to have more field projects and awareness campaigns in order to connect better with the local society.


7. Dr. Bankim Mohanty, ED cum Secretary, declared that an open gym shall be placed for the health conscious students. He had decided to do so as the local gym, with which the institute had a tie-up, was not quite used by the students due to the distance.

8. Ms. Monalisha Mallick proposed to mentor some of the finance specialization students for Analyst positions.

9. Er. Kamala Kanta Pradhan suggested 6-months VAC with an industrial tie-up.

10. The meeting concluded with a vote of thanks by Asst. Prof. Manoranjan Nayak and it was unanimously decided that all the points discussed should be sincerely considered and simultaneously executed. All members sang the National Anthem.

Points of Discussion:

1. Prof. Dr. Sharmila Subramanian Welcomed all Members of IQAC, and narrated the purpose of calling a mid-term meeting.
2. The IQAC coordinator, Asst. Prof. M. Nayak, presented the NAAC results and read out the comments given by the peer team.
3. The members expressed their disappointment over 2.99 score that resulted in B++. The members expected "A".
4. There was brainstorming over further plan of action with respect to the NAAC peer team report. The members showed their disappointment over the score given for the Distinctiveness of the Institution. Er. KK Pradhan felt remorseful that academicians who visited the campus as NAAC Team members were oblivious of the importance of Human Values and Spiritualism for holistic education.
5. Asst. Prof. Abhipsa Mishra stressed upon integrating OB lab with the OB curriculum even if it wasn't a part the university prescribed course.
5. Asst. Prof. Dipan Kumar Jena presented a report on the field visit of the students that connected modern management with IKS.
6. Mrs. Bishnupriya Biswal, trustee, suggested to work on the issues raised in the NAAC report. This was aided by remarks from Dr. Bankim Mohanty, ED cum Secretary, who discussed his plans for utilizing the infrastructure, and adding smart classrooms.
7. Mr. Hrudanand Pradhan suggested bringing in, better management of the canteen by getting FSSAI certificate.
